PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Dencoat™ Floor Care is a highly concentrated neutral, low foaming wax care product.

APPLICATIONS

For the care and maintenance of Dencoat™ flooring systems. Use immediately after using Dencoat™ Floor Cleaner in order to maintain floor luster and resiliency, as well as prevent the drying out of the surface.

BENEFITS AND FEATURES

Dencoat™ Floor Care preserves the floor luster and resiliency and facilitates the daily cleaning.

CHARACTERISTICS

Brown liquid.

WORKING METHODS AND DOSAGE

Manual cleaning:
With a brush, sponge or the like.
High pressure:
With steam, hot water or cold water.
When using the wax-oil solution:
Use scrubbing machine. The dirty surfaces soak for ½-10 minutes prior to scrubbing.
Wash or rinse with water.
Particularly thorough rinsing:
Performed at floors that are exposed to foodstuffs and meatproducts. It is important that the floor does not float in the liquid, since this can cause stripes.
Dosage:
Dilute with warm or hot water at 1 dl to 8 L of water. For cleaning machine use 3% in the tank.
The dosage can be increased to 3 dl per 8 l for rapid achievement of high gloss.

Refined wax, acrylic dispersion, emulsifiers, alkali salts, perfume, in aqueous solution.
